DEFINITIONS:

Cash: The amount you have on deposit at a Bank(s).

Marketable Securities: Financial assets that can easily be traded on public markets. i.e., Stocks, bonds, mutual funds, etc.

Personal Residence: The value of the residence that you own and occupy.

Other Real Estate: The value of any other real estate that you own. Ex./second home or investment property.

Cash Surrender Value of Life Insurance: Depending on the type of life insurance you have, there may be a “cash value” which is the savings component you would receive if you canceled your policy.

Business Value: The value of the Business you own.

Other Investments: Any investments not previously listed.

Other Assets: Cars, jewelry, art, etc.

Liabilities: Debt; loans that you owe to someone else.

Residential Real Estate Debt/HELOC: The mortgage(s) on the residence that you occupy.

Other Real Estate Debt: The mortgage(s) on other real estate that you own. Ex./second home or investment property.
